The error message is:</p> <pre>\$ v.db.addcol map=myarchsites columns="descr varchar(12)" c:/Programmi/Quantum: c:/Programmi/Quantum: No such file or directory</pre> <p>White space in the default install path is a problem.</p> <p>In previous version this issue was fixed.
