<p>During experimenting with QGIS version 2.2 "Relations" where Foreign Key relations from a database can be documented, so that the QGIS UI can (auto) generate its Attribute Editor Layout in Master-Detail / Parent-Child forms. See http://gis.stackexchange.com/questions/91991, there seems to be a bug with DragAndDrop attribute editor layout, an error message "Error: Field does not exist in datasource" appears in the place of the detail layer/relation.</p>
