<p>The command Vector &gt; Analysis tool &gt; Statistics does not return, as header, the name of the layer and that of the variable analysed. This is not a big issue in direct usage, but becomes a serious limitation when the alg is used in Processing, as the output is saved without any clue about what it refers to.</p> <p>Seems a trivial and useful addition.</p>
