<b>Description</b>		
<p>The "Save as" dialog of a layer is misleading.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Load a WGS84 layer (I used a random shapefile).</li><li>2. In the Project Properties enable OTF reprojection and select a different CRS (I used EPSG 25832).</li><li>3. Right-click the layer and "Save as..."</li><li>4. Select "Project CRS". See the attachment for what the dialog now looks like. It suggests that EPSG 4326 will be used by displaying that in the grey field.</li><li>5. Press "OK" to save, it will actually save correctly as EPSG 25832.</li></ol> <p>I assume the greyed out field is only used for "selected CRS" because when that option is selected, it becomes white (not editable though?).</p> <p>I would suggest displaying the CRS that will be used in that field. Leave it grey all the time. Alternatively not displaying that field at all unless "selected CRS" is selected.</p>
