<b>Description</b>	
<p>There should be a multi-edit form mode. When activated, one can edit multiple fields at once and the edited fields would apply to all selected or filtered elements.</p> <p>To warn users that they are in multi-edit mode, the widget background could be displayed in red. This should avoid accidental multi-edits. An apply-button would commit the values to all selected or filtered features. The use can decide whether it applies to filter or selection.</p>
