<p>I'm trying to upload my first plugin to: http://plugins.qgis.org/plugins/add/</p> <p>I keep getting the following error:</p> <p>There were errors reading plugin package (please check also your plugin's metadata). Package name must start with an ASCII letter and can contain ASCII letters, digits and the signs '-' and '_'.</p> <p>My package name is "DEMTools" and I've checked the plugin's metadata file, but everything looks to be in order. This error message doesn't give me a lot to go on and I've never uploaded a plugin before. I doubt it is a bug with the uploader, but rather some error I've made. Are there some common issues I should look for or is there some detailed guide to creating a plugin package for upload?</p> <p>I've attached the plugin package zip file that is causing the error. Any help is greatly appreciated.</p>
