<p>A user reported a bug during edition of an attribute table under QGIS2.4.</p> <p>To reproduce :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- create a vector layer with one "text" field (for example "foo") and add it in the current project- open layer properties / Field tab, and check the "multiline" property of the "Text edit" for the field "foo"- create 2 features with some content in the "foo" field- save layer session and deactivate edition- open attribute table, activate edition, toggle to the Form view- click on one of the line in the left panel -> the line label changes into NULL- click on another line in the left panel -> same behaviour.- go back and select the first line -> the value in the "foo" field has bee completely erased- toggle edition off, save -> no more values in the "foo" field.
