I am using rule based layers as well, but I noticed that with this combination I cannot edit the SHP file - I wanted to do a copy and paste from another SHP file. Is this done for any reason or can editing be supported with this mode?</p> <p>At the moment my only work around is to open the files without these queries attached and then do a copy and paste and then save on them.</p> <p>Unsure if this is a bug or a feature request.</p>
