<p>For some reason, QGIS Desktop generates an extra/null symbol for categorized layer styles. This happens, at least, on vector layers. The extra symbol need to be removed by an user, manually. The symbol is automatically generated each time you push classify button.</p> <p>See picture attachment. Symbols 1-5 are correct, and the null symbol at the bottom of the list (blue one) shouldn't be there.</p>
