Turns out QPrinter::setPaperSize silently flips the width and height of a page if the printer orientation is set to landscape. So, make sure we manually set the orientation to portrait before setting the page size so that we can be sure the QPrinter is set to the correct page size.

This also restores the 2.4 behaviour where users could override printed page size in the printer properties dialog (but only if no data defined page size settings are active).
