<p>I use this plugin because i want to get the most up-to date data from osm</p> <p>Qgis is bad at handling multiple items on a single layer.</p> <p>So for example, i have the multiple polygons that contain everything</p> <p>They have the Buildings</p> <p>They have the Landuse</p> <p>They have the Amenity</p> <p>Is impossible to style all of the different items, and still be easy to modify after-all</p> <p>I can do this with a style-rule approach, and this is not ideal</p> <p>This is why i prefer to export to a file ONLY the Buildings</p> <p>To another file only the Landuse</p> <p>To another file only the Amenity</p> <p>In this way is more simple to style the individual files</p> <p>In the current implementation i can only filter the TAGS that i want to export, but not the type of tag that i want to export</p> <p>For example, if i want just the Buildings, i have to do :</p> <p>Export file, select the building tags to export.</p> <p>Open the db file that i exported, make a SQL statement to exclude the NULL argument</p> <p>Save as a new file</p> <p>Load the new file</p>
