<p>Using qgis desktop, qgis server 2.4 on fedora, I can launch GetCapabilities request but it contains no layers.</p> <p>.qgs contains relative path for data source (&lt;datasource&gt;./echantillonage.shp&lt;/datasource&gt;)</p> <p>I manually edit .qgs so I can set an absolute path instead a relative path for datasource ( &lt;datasource&gt;/opt/geodata/echantillonage.shp&lt;/datasource&gt;)and GetCapabilities returns the layers.</p> <p>But as soon I edit my project in qgis desktop and save it, It overwrites my modification and re-create relative paths and the WMS still contains no layers</p>
