<b>Description</b>  On Japanese MacOSX, R returns stdout and stderr messages in Japanese. Processing's Log displays those lines in wrong encoding and causes what is called mojibake.  This may be fixed by modifying createConsoleOutput in RUtils.py, but I am not quite sure.
