<p>Strange problem - when adding a shapefile to a project FOR THE FIRST TIME, the PRJ is often but not always ignored. If I then remove the shapefile, or quit QGIS, and add it again, the PRJ is read. All subsequent adding of that shapefile will read the PRJ.</p> <p>QGIS is not changing the shapefile or adding a QPJ file, and I couldn't find anything in my .qgis2 folder that keeps track of what has been opened, so it's very mysterious why only a first-time open doesn't work. Very frustrating when I'm rectifying dozens of images each with its own generated grid shapefile for the GCPs, I have to open each grid shapefile twice.</p>
