Add a WFS layer (I added a GeoServer default layer 'tiger:poi')</li><li>2. Make an edit</li><li>3. Try to save your edits</li></ol> <p>Result: QGIS sends a WFS POST request, which in its contents use "&amp;" in the schema location instead of "&amp;":</p> <p>xsi:schemaLocation="http://www.census.gov <a href="http://my.server/geoserver/wfs?SERVICE=WFS&amp;&amp;&amp;VERSION=1.0.0&amp;&amp;&amp;REQUEST=DescribeFeatureType&amp;&amp;&amp;TYPENAME=tiger:poi&amp;&amp;&amp;SRSNAME=EPSG:4326">http://my.server/geoserver/wfs?SERVICE=WFS&amp;&amp;&amp;VERSION=1.0.0&amp;&amp;&amp;REQUEST=DescribeFeatureType&amp;&amp;&amp;TYPENAME=tiger:poi&amp;&amp;&amp;SRSNAME=EPSG:4326</a>"</p> <p>which results in an empty response from the server, leaving QGIS to wait for the request to time out until responding with e.g.:</p> <div><p><i>Commit errors</i></p><p><i>Could not commit changes to layer tiger:poi</i></p><p><i>Errors: ERROR: 1 feature(s) not deleted.</i></p><p><i>Provider errors:</i></p><p><i>empty response</i></p></div>
