<p>I've tried to install QGIS 2.6.1 on my Windows 7, x64 machine, but the installer keeps on stopping when it is about 80% done.</p> <p>The error I'm receiving is:</p> <p>-----</p> <p>QGIS Brighton (2.6.1) Setup</p> <p>-----</p> <p>Extract: error writing to file pal2rgb.exe</p> <p>-----</p> <p>OK</p> <p>-----</p> <p>FYI. I've also received errors for file "proj.dll", but approximately the same percentage done.</p> <p>I've tried installing the application to both C:\Program Files\... and E:\Program Files\ (my preferred location), but with no success. Is there anything else I can try?</p> <p>I have QGIS 1.6 already installed, but in a separate directory (e:\Program Files (x86)\Quantum GIS Copiapo\).</p> <p>There is more than enough space on the drive (100GB+).</p>
