setShowingAllLabels(True) doesn't work from python :

```
myMapRenderer = self.iface.mapCanvas().mapRenderer()
mLBL = QgsPalLabeling()
mLBL.setShowingAllLabels(True)
myMapRenderer.setLabelingEngine(mLBL)
print 'Showing all : ' + str(myMapRenderer.labelingEngine().isShowingAllLabels())
# Return True, but doesn't work
```
