<p>In DB Manager -> SQL Window, if you write a SQL query, run and then change some parameter, making the selection with the mouse, the query does not work/update. On the other hand, if you delete and write the new parameter, then it works. In other words, you must move the cursor with the keyboard.</p> <p>I made a short screencast because it is not very easy to explain.
