<p>I had a shapefile I made available as a WFS-service with QGis Server.</p> <p>OpenLayers 3 kept giving me an error. Turns out I was using a path in the shapefile, D:\\location-on-disk , that was giving us some trouble.</p> <p>It seems like the JSON spec would require that it is properly escaped.</p> <p>So the GeoJSON contains something like "myProperty" : "D:\\location-on-disk" instead of "myProperty" : "D:\\\\location-on-disk".</p>
