<b>Description</b>		
<p>Installation of h5py is very problematic, especially for fresh QGIS users. Adding it to the official distribution would save them a lot of troubles.</p> <p>The h5py (<a href="http://h5py.org">http://h5py.org</a>) package is a Pythonic interface to the HDF5 binary data format. It lets you store huge amounts of numerical data, and easily manipulate that data from NumPy (requires NumPy 1.6.1 or newer).</p> <p>The h5py package is required by RiverGIS QGIS plugin (<a href="http://rivergis.com">http://rivergis.com</a>).</p> <p>Thanks a lot in advance!</p>
