<b>Description</b>		
<p>When using rulebased styles in combination with a data defined angle for a svg symbol, the rotate tool is not availble for the layer. My current workaround is to use a slider field to set the correct angle of the data defined field. This is cumbersome and error-prone. Also the map is not updated correctly right away, making it very hard to see the angle of an icon.</p> <p>The best solution would be to allow for data defined angles in the rulebased style, just like the other styles. I'm assuming the rotate tool will work fine then.</p>
