By making the overlap of three layers, eg (A Union B) intersection D</p> <p>You should give the three fields: nombre (CapaA.shp), nombre_1 (CapaB.shp) and hnombre_2 (CapaD.shp), yet it is ignored one of the fields, without providing the complete info of the three layers, ie, one the fields are overwriting.</p>
