<p>When attempting to perform a join on a shapefile layer from the layer properties dialogue box, if a table is not present in the QGIS project, QGIS will crash.</p> <p>To reproduce:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- create a new QGIS project</li><li>- add a .SHP to the map</li><li>- open the layer properties dialogue box</li><li>- click the 'Joins' section</li><li>- click the '+' icon to add a join</li><li>- QGIS should crash</li></ul> <p>I have tried this on 1 Ubuntu machine and 2 Windows machines</p>
