<p>We've seen an issue with Snapping to new features.</p> <p>When you digitize a feature, snapping will work in Modes Advanced or Current Layer, until you save that layer. Once saved, I've found that you need to re-load the dataset to be able to snap to those features.</p> <p>If you use All Layers, it does work, however this mode is almost unusable in Windows 7 and MAC OSX. As the Reindexing Data window appears each time the mouse cursor moves.</p> <p>This means your mouse cursor needs to be completely still to create a vertex and slows productivity.</p> <p>Is it possible to re-index after a layer has been saved?</p> <p>Datasource: PostgreSQL 9.3 / PostGIS OS: Windows 7 / MAC OSX QGIS Version: 2.10.1</p>
