<p>When assigning the font size from an "unknown type" in the rule-based labeling, QGIS crashes:</p> <p>1- Unzip and open the attached spatialite file</p> <p>2- Assign a rule based label</p> <p>3- Select font size to be from FONTHEIGHT field</p> <p>QGIS crashes with sef fault.</p> <p>This doesn't happen with the "Show labels for this layer" option.</p>
