<p>When assigning the font size from an "unknown type" in the rule-based labeling, QGIS crashes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1- Unzip and open the attached spatialite file</li><li>2- Assign a rule based label</li><li>3- Select font size to be from FONTHEIGHT field</li></ol> <p>QGIS crashes with seg fault.</p> <p>This doesn't happen with the "Show labels for this layer" option.</p>
