<p>Please, see attached image to understand the thread:</p> <p>A - definition of thresholds for the color legend</p> <p>B - visualisation of color legend in TOC</p> <p>C - example what I am capable to construct via legend properties to map composer</p> <p>My wish:</p> <p>D - vertical color gradient with correct position of values (see offset next to the interval threshold), no outline forthe interval colors</p> <p>E - represents D, transformed to horizontal position</p> <p>I do not know, how much work it is to implement features for creating such legend, but that would be really helpful.</p> <p>I work with various kinds of gridded data for 15+ years on daily basis; E option would cover 90% of my needs for legend. It is logically correct and compact to save space in the layout. A lot of "unGIS" software/libs (like Matplotlib+Basemap) offer such legend type.</p>
