I'm not sure if this behaviour is good but why not, since it shows how layer will be.</div> <div>Now Click "OK" in the query builder dialog and click "CANCEL" in the Properties Dialog : your layer will be kept queried, despite you cancelled the process.</div> <div>Shouldn't all the not yet applied changes, made within the Layer Properties dialog, be reversed when user hits Cancel button?</div> <div>Occured since QGIS 2.4 at least</div>
