Now Click "OK" in the query builder dialog and click "CANCEL" in the Properties Dialog : your layer will be kept queried, despite you cancelled the process.</p> <p>Shouldn't all the not yet applied changes, made within the Layer Properties dialog, be reversed when user hits Cancel button?</p> <p>Occured since QGIS 2.4 at least</p>
