<p>Coordinates in tfw files are little bit off of the exact bounding box.</p> <p>When bounding box of a map is even (224000, 7008000, 230000, 7014000) coordinates in tfw are 224000.000113 and 7013999.999805. Actually these coordinates should be center coordinates of the upper left pixel (see issue #13728).</p> <p>There are also some unnecessary line breaks in tfw files.</p> <p>When opened in notepad++ it shows one empty line between all the values.</p>
