<p>Open the properties window for a layer in the layers panel.</p> <p>The dialog opens, but the main application behind the window is greyed out, and the 'properties' window cannot be re-positioned independently of the main application.</p> <p>(This obscures the main application so that you can't use the apply button effectively, and renders features such as the color picker (in the 'styles' menu) unusable).</p>
