<p>Hi, and sorry for my english level.</p> <p>Each time i'm trying to delete one geometry, it doesn't work. It seems to work in QGIS but not, the deleted geometry always reappear in others software.</p> <p>If I don't correct this problem and i continue to work on a shapefile containing 'ghost geometries', i obtain an offset between geometries and attribute line.</p> <p>You can check this by showing feature count, when you're deleting one geometry, the feature count decreases. When you're saving change in the layer, the feature count increase again.</p> <p>It also happen for each spatial operation which make disappear geometry or which need to replace geometries.</p> <p>This probleme was already existing in the 2.8 version, perhaps in previous one also.</p>
