<p>From the Style Library you can :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Export to PNG : export to distinct PNG files the selected symbols- Export to SVG : export to distinct SVG files the selected symbols- Export : opens a dialog to select the desired symbols, should they be Marker, Line, Fill or Color ramp item. It then saves these symbols into a single xml file. <p>It may be more handy to have a single Export button that still opens the symbol selection dialog with an option to choose the file format at its bottom.</p> <p>If xml is choosen, it'll generate one file containing all selected symbols and if SVG or PNG is selected, it'll create as many files as selected symbols.</p>
