<p>Hi all, We're using QGis 2.12 on fedora, and it works quite fine</p> <p>Here's the problem : when digitising, if we are filling a numeric field with more than 1 digit, it will save, no problem... But after exiting and restarting Qgis (for a new day of work, for example...), it won't be possible to save any value in this field...</p> <p>We've temporarily solve the problem by creating a text field, instead of the numeric, digitise everything, then, when it's done, create a new field, with the field calculator, of numeric type...</p>
