The data associated with this object is not deleted from the .shp file.</p> <p>1) Create a new Shapefile (ponct). 2) Create 3 points 3) Delete the 2th point.</p> <p>The .dbf contains 2 rows (it's ok) but the file "*.shp" is strictly the same as before the deletion.
