<p>A frequent question is how to find the correct projection for layers without a .prj or similar.</p> <p>An interesting approach is this: <a href="http://projfinder.com/">http://projfinder.com/</a> (not usable as it is for us, as it is strongly biased towards North America).</p> <p>IMHO it would be useful, probably not too difficult, to implement it in QGIS.
