## QGIS crash after closing the file dialog

<b>Description</b>	
<p>After closing a file dialog, QGIS crash and show a minidump popup. It is not possible to open a file, open a project or save a project without crash. Even if the dialog is left with escape (without choosing a file) QGIS crashes.</p> <p>It is possible to open files with the browser or with the file tree. But this workaround doesn't work for the geo-reference dialog.</p> <p>Tried with version 2.12.3 and with 2.8.4 (* 2.12.3 is missing in the selection 'Affected version' of the bug tracker page, therefore I selected 2.12.2)</p> <p>How to repeat: start QGIS, choose Ctrl-O (open file), press ESC (or choose one file)</p>
