<p>I merged two features, a new one and an old one, keeping the attributes of the one that was already in the database.</p> <p>I expected QGIS to add the merged feature before deleting the old one but instead it tries to delete the old one first and fails because that would cascade to a table with a restrictive FK. Is this intended and if so does this mean I have to drop the FK when I want to merge or can this behaviour be improved?</p>
