I have two layers - settlement point layer and polygon layer, which contains an object that I would like to use as an obstacle for the labels of settlements. I'm applying the following steps:

- 1. Label settlements with Show labels for this layer option, as a result some labels cover polygon boundary
- 2. In the polygon layer Properties dialogue I select Labels > Discourage other labels from covering features in this layer, and click OK
- 3. Nothing changes, and when I check *Properties > Labels* of the polygon layer the option is set to the default *No labels* value.

The same steps work perfectly fine in 2.12.3
