<p>I have two layers - settlement point layer and polygon layer, which contains an object that I would like to use as an obstacle for the labels of settlements. I'm applying the following steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Label settlements with <i>Show labels for this layer</i> option, as a result some labels cover polygon boundary2. In the polygon layer <i>Properties</i> dialogue I select <i>Labels > Discourage other labels from covering features in this layer</i>, and click OK3. Nothing changes, and when I check <i>Properties > Labels</i> of the polygon layer the option is set to the default <i>No labels</i> value. <p>The same steps work perfectly fine in 2.12.3</p>
