#### Description

From a clean build, or after  
find -name \*.moc |xargs rm

I get:

```
.../tests/src/core/testqgsinvertedpolygonrenderer.cpp:196:46: fatal error: testqgsinvertedpolygonrenderer.moc: Aucun fichier ou dossier de ce type
```

If I edit the tests/src/core/CMakeLists.txt, changing the name of the test, the build succeed, I can change it back to what it was and build will again succeed.

I'm building on Ubuntu 15.10 with cmake version 3.2.2

Is there something I'm missing, can someone else reproduce ?
