<p>QGIS appears to lock all the files within a folder even though it is accessing only a subset of the files.</p> <p>I created a new text file within a folder where QGIS is accessing a raster. Once the text file is created, I can no longer edit it. This is true of other GIS files that QGIS is not accessing.</p> <p>Version is 2.8.6 but I cannot select that below</p>
