| <p>After Install of the actual QGIS Build on my work-PC, via OSGeo Installer, JP2 files are loaded extremely slowly and are eventually displayed as black squares.</p> <p>As long as these files are turned on in the legend, the performance is extremely bad (waiting minutes for display refresh instead of seconds)</p> <p>I installed QGIS today on a fresh PC (with the OSGEO Installer) for testing, but the result remains the same.</p> <p>I suspect that the GDAL Provider is playing tricks on us.</p> <p>The JP2 files are downloadable from the official Flemish GIS Portal at download.agiv.be</p> <p>Here is a download link to one of these files.</p> <p>https://downloadagiv.blob.core.windows.net/omwrgb15vl/Per%20provincie%20per%20gemeente/Antwerpen/OMWRGB15VL_12021.zip</p> <p>For the time being, i will not upgrade my end-users</p> <p>Regards</p> <p>Luc Janssens</p> <p>GIS-Coördinator</p> <p>City of Lier, Belgium</p> | | |
