Steps to reproduce:

- 1. Open QGIS.
- 2. Open Shape file with atleast one attribute with varying values.
- 3. Show the layer.
- 4. Zoom to layer.
- 5. Zoom in on a feature.
- 6. Create a filter (Right click layer, select filter, filter on something).
- 7. Zoom to layer.

Now what happens for me is that it doesn't zoom to layer. When dragging the map (using the hand) the view just jumps back when I release the drag.

I would expect the zoom to layer was working and that I would be able to resume working normally with QGIS afterwards.

This occurs both in the latest 2.14 x64 Windows release and in MASTER 81be559.
