<p>When calling an action from the context menu (right click) on an attribute window, the value obtained from a field name does not show.</p> <p>Python action example: print "Value of myattribute: {}".format(['% "myattribute" %']) only prints "Value of myattribute:" not adding the actually value.</p> <p>The same action used from the Action map tool button writes out the field value also as expected.</p> <p>Tested on Windows 7 OSGEO4W QGIS version 2.14.1 and QGIS master.</p>
