<p>Debian self compiled master here. Starting up with it's own config path (--configpath) I had troubles adding newly created Geoserver WMS layers (http://osgeo-org.1560.x6.nabble.com/WMS-provider-Cannot-calculate-extent-t5250516.html and #13762) and tried to fiddle with the cache directory.</p> <p>After setting it, the layer immediatly loaded ???</p> <p>But after a qgis restart, the cache directory was not saved (empty 'Directory' input, see screenshot).</p> <p>BUT I can load the wms layer again.</p> <p>Adding a new layer I had the same problem..</p> <p>As said, I think this maybe has something todo with #13762</p>
