Description

Hi.

I have notice that from QGIS 2.8 labels and point symbols are not rotated in print composer (while changing map rotation) but they are still horizontal. In previus versions of QGIS they where horizontal to the north direction. I have attached two files to show what I mean. Is there a feature or bug? Is there any option to make that labels and symbols rotate according to the north direction in print composer? Regards!

This is a feature, not a bug. You could manually set rotation for the labels/symbols if you don't want this behaviour, and can take advantage of data defined rotation using the map_rotation variable to have it automatically update with the rotation.
