Steps to reproduce

- 2. Open the style dock, activate labeling
- 3. Go to the labeling's position tab, and change the priority slider
- 4. Don't hit [apply], close the style dock
- 5. Re-open the style dock, you'll notice the priority slider is reset back to the default value
