The labeling's priority slider is broken when set through the style dock's live update.	
Steps to reproduce	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Create a new project, add a vector layer2. Open the style dock, activate labeling3. Go to the labeling's position tab, and change the priority slider4. Don't hit [apply], close the style dock5. Re-open the style dock, you'll notice the priority slider is reset back to the default value
