<p>If you use a raster image and switch to "Singleband gray" in the Layer Styling panel it will not automatically load the Min/Max.</p> <p>If you do the same in the Style properties dialog you automatically get "0" for both (which is an error).</p> <p>The pseudocolor options automatically load values for me, please do the same for gray.</p> <p>I would also suggest automatically applying "Stretch to MinMax" Contrast enhancement as user friendly default.</p> <p>I am on 7343b36, Linux.</p>
